- I. **Core Area:**
 - A. Where is your Core Area?
 - B. Have you determined access areas to the Core Area?
 - C. Have you established the features and furniture in the Core Area including the condition of those items?
- II. **Witness Statement**
 - A. Did you explain:
 - i. Who the witness is...
 - ii. Who interviewed them...
 - iii. When they were interviewed...
 - iv. What specific questions they were asked...
 - v. Are the questions providing objective facts when answered.
- III. **The Mock-up Model**
 - A. Is the model oriented the same way the description and solution are written?
 - B. Is the mock-up susceptible to multiple solutions? If so how can you minimize significant misinterpretation?
 - C. Is the model "over-dependent" on data outside of the core area?
- IV. **Additional List of Information**
 - A. Did the list provide specific information about the condition of items in the core area? (TV on or off, candles lit etc)
 - B. Overt smells or scents in the room?
 - C. Can anything be heard from outside the core area?
